2. Respect the rights, dignity and value of each and every person and treat everyone equally within the context of the sport.
3. Always display high standards of behaviour and not bring the club or themselves into disrepute. Foul and abusive language and bad sportsmanship by word or deed will not be tolerated.
4. Respect referees and assistant referees. Their decisions must be accepted without argument or dispute.
5. Pay all fines, which are incurred as a result of their actions or behaviour.
6. Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.

Failure to comply with this code of conduct could result in immediate suspension and possible expulsion from the club.
